CODECASA 65

On Saturday June 1st, Cantieri Navali Codecasa launched Construction F74, a Codecasa steel and lightweight aluminium alloy superyacht before a restricted private audience. This robust yacht was built to Lloyd's Register norms with a view to obtain the highest degree of compliance with the LY3 Commercial Yacht Code from the MCA, which is a letter of Compliance as Unrestricted Yacht after having obtained the highest RINA class.

The power house is made up of a couple of 2,448 Hp Caterpillar 2516C engines. The yacht's top speed is of 17 knots and at 12 knots the yacht can cover 5,000 nautical miles. Furthermore it features water treatment plants, which collect bilge water, ballast and liquids in addition to sewage. It is also equipped with a cold storage room, and one for biodegradable oils from the drives' stuffing boxes and from rudder blade shafts. This is to show and to confirm that Codecasa cares about environmental sustainability. An Italian leasing company owns Codecsa F74. The entire interior layout project was carried out in collaboration with M2 Atelier from Milan, Italy.
